## Instruction to the Candidates for Written Test

Post notified: Manager (Legal)

Date of Test : 16-06- 2019 (SUNDAY) 10-00 a.m. to 1-00.p.m

The Examination would be for 3 hrs

*The medium of answering the questions shall be English only.*

The Examination is of two parts.

1. **Objective type** – 10-00 to 11-30 a.m.

90 multiple choice - objective type questions – Maximum Marks 45 – Time : One and half hour.

These questions are to be answered on a separate sheet given for that purpose.

**Answers are to be indicated.** The Answer sheet and the question paper booklet of objective type shall be returned by the candidate immediately after one and half hour and before taking the question paper relating to descriptive model. The question paper relating to descriptive model will not be supplied unless the answer sheet relating to objective type along with the question paper booklet of objective type is handed over. **There is no negative marking for objective type questions.**

2. **Question paper relating to descriptive type** 11-30 a.m. to 1-00 p.m. - Separate answer booklet will be supplied for this type. It consists of two parts.

Part – I : Consists of five short note questions out of which the candidate shall answer 3 questions. Maximum marks 10.

Part II – Consists of 3 Problem/ drafting/analyses based questions out of which the candidate shall answer 2 questions - Maximum marks :25.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Test Centre for the Written Exam: SATHIYABHAMA INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (Deemed to be University), RAJIV GANDHI ROAD, CHENNAI -600119, TAMIL NADU.**
2. **Admit Card/ Hall Ticket** will be sent by NLC. No candidate will be allowed to enter into the examination hall without the **Admit Card/ Hall Ticket**.
3. **Particulars to be Noted:** Note carefully your Roll No., on answer sheet of objective type question paper, and on answer sheet given for descriptive type.
4. **Compliance with Instructions:** The Candidates should follow the instructions given by the test administrators and the invigilators at all stages of the Examination. If any candidate violates the instructions, he/she may be disqualified and may also be asked to leave the Test Center forthwith.
5. **Use of calculators, cell phones or any electronic gadgets, books, notes is strictly prohibited and copying or receiving / giving assistance is not allowed:** Any candidate who is found either copying or receiving or giving assistance will be disqualified and it will be treated as malpractice and necessary action will be taken. Possession and use of incriminating material for the purpose of the test amounts to malpractice and necessary action will be taken
6. Any candidate who does not return any of the test materials as required or is found in attempting to take or pass on the question booklet or answer sheets inside or outside the examination hall will be disqualified.
7. The candidates are required to **fill in the information asked for on the answer sheet and question booklet, otherwise their answer sheet may not be evaluated.** Indicating any other marks or symbols or words on the answer sheets will result in disqualification.
8. The candidates should not leave their seats unless permitted.
9. The candidates may do their rough work, if any, on the question booklet itself and **not on the answer sheets.**
10. The candidates are required to check all the pages and questions in their question booklet before starting to write answers. If something is missing or not properly printed, or is damaged, request may be made to the invigilator to give another booklet.
11. The candidates have to make their own arrangements to reach and leave the Test Centre.
12. Candidates will not be allowed after 30 minutes of the commencement of the examination.

## TIMINGS :

1. **First Bell (long) will be given at 9-30 a.m.** the candidates will be allowed to enter into the examination hall and sit in their allotted seats.
2. **Second Bell (long) will be given at 9-55 a.m.** Immediately **Objective type Question Booklet** will be supplied to the candidates along with answer sheets. The candidates are required to first fill the particulars required
3. **Third Bell (Short) will be given at 10-00 a.m.** – Starting of examination
4. **Fourth Bell (short) will be given at 11-30 a.m.** - *The candidates shall hand over the answer sheet and OBJECTIVE TYPE QP immediately.* The candidate will be supplied with descriptive type question paper along with answer booklets.
5. **Fifth Bell (short) will be given at 12-55 p.m.** - A warning bell to the candidates to stop writing, fasten their sheets tightly and securely.
6. **Sixth Bell (long) will be given at 1-00 p.m.** - The candidates should immediately hand over the answer sheets to the invigilator and leave the hall.

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
